Happy City is an apolitical not-for-profit initiative. It has no links to any religious, political or extremist organisation, and no hidden agenda.

We just want a happier Bristol too. Here's a bit more detail about how it all works in practice....

Events

At fast paced, fun, inspiring events held in communities across the city people will:

- * Explore their visions of a happier community
- * Discover the things that are already happening to increase happiness in their neighbourhoods
- * Enable and inspire each other to come together to support and cultivate success to build happiness

Participants and trained community connectors will then take the thinking, learning, tools and approaches from these events and use them in schools, groups, homes and public spaces throughout their communities. Spreading the seeds of happiness virally.

Communication

A range of broad reaching awareness campaigns targeted at all members of society will:

- * Stimulate thought through the use of images, questions, and invitations.
- * Provoke conversations, curiosity and interest
- * Inform people about sources of information including events and the website

Communications will be ongoing, varied in style and will feature celebrations of success and progress reports as well of continued calls to action.
